Biographical Note

Conrad M. Arensberg was born on September 12, 1910 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Academically inclined from a young age, he excelled at school and graduated first in his class at Shadyside Academy in Pittsburgh. His early success earned him admittance into Harvard College. When he left for Cambridge, he was “singing for joy over each of the seven ridges of the Alleghenies, vowing never ever to return, but to remain forever in the greater world of Boston and beyond” (Comitas 2000).

Harvard brought out Arensberg’s intellectual curiosity. He struggled to decide on a major and was torn between history, anthropology, and English. After taking a variety of classes and traveling through Europe, Arensberg settled on anthropology. He excelled in his studies, and in 1931, at the end of his senior year, the Dean of the College exempted him from his final exams, seeing them as “being completely unnecessary in Conrad’s case” (Comitas 2000). He graduated summa cum laude.

As a graduate student, Arensberg was asked to join a project being conducted in Ireland by Harvard’s Anthropology Department. Alongside W. Lloyd Warner and Solon T. Kimball, Arensberg spent three years studying rural Irish life in County Clare. This research resulted in his doctoral dissertation, “A Study in Rural Life in Ireland as Determined by the Functions and Morphology of the Family,” which was later published as “The Irish Countryman” in 1937. His work was groundbreaking in the field of anthropology, and his study of County Clare “became a model for other community studies...requiring that researchers study a target culture from the inside, making meticulous notes on everything they saw, heard or experienced.” Arensberg reshaped the way that anthropologists approached fieldwork and opened doors for the study of modern industrial societies.

While his Ireland study is the most well known of his research, Arensberg had a diverse array of interests that led him to collaborate with colleagues in a variety of fields. His bibliography includes many co-authored works with friends such as Solon T. Kimball, Eliot D. Chapple, Karl Polanyi, Geoffrey Tootell, and Alan Lomax. These focus on areas such as industrial studies, economics, human relations and behavior. In addition to these endeavors Arensberg traveled as a research consultant. In the early 1950s he spent time in Germany as UNESCO’s Research Director for the Institute for the Social Sciences. He was a Fellow at the Center for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences in Palo Alto, California in the late 1950s. In the 1960s he served as the Principal Investigator for the India Community Studies Project.

Arensberg’s varied research interests provided him with a broad range of experience and knowledge to bring to the classroom. He first became a university professor in 1938 at MIT, and remained a professor for the rest of his life, teaching at MIT, Brooklyn College, Barnard College, Columbia University, the University of Florida, and the University of Virginia. At Columbia, Arensberg worked alongside such notable anthropologists as Margaret Mead, Charles Wagley, and Marvin Harris. Despite his consistently heavy workload, Arensberg made time for his students—“He served on countless numbers of

social science doctoral defenses, and he was advisor, formal or informal, to almost every social or cultural anthropology graduate student on campus or in the field” (Comitas 2000). His influence can be seen in the work of his students.

Always active professionally, Arensberg belonged to numerous “learned societies” as he called them. He was one of the founders of the Society for Applied Anthropology in the early 1940s and served as the organization’s president several times. He joined the American Anthropological Association in 1933 during his graduate years at Harvard and was elected President in 1980. He often served as Program Chair for various professional meetings and belonged to such diverse organizations as the American Geographical Society, the Industrial Relations Research Association, the American Academy for the Advancement of Science, and the American Sociological Society.

Arensberg officially retired in 1979, but he continued to collaborate with his colleagues, counsel past students, and participate in professional associations until his death. He passed away on February 10, 1997 in a nursing home in Hazlet, New Jersey after suffering from respiratory failure.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains the professional papers of Conrad M. Arensberg, anthropologist, university professor, and anthropological consultant. Included are correspondence; published and unpublished writings; research materials, including notes, correspondence, diaries, charts, drafts, interviews, research plans, reports, project proposals, and bibliographic cards; speeches; pamphlets; articles from newspapers and periodicals; course materials, including bibliographies, lecture notes, reading lists, assignments, exams, project proposals, and syllabi; curriculum vitae; date books; scholarly papers and publications of other scholars; and photographs.

The materials in this collection document Arensberg's career as a university professor, his relationships with colleagues across a spectrum of disciplines, and his contributions to the field of Anthropology. As a respected member of the anthropological community, Arensberg received a voluminous amount of correspondence from his peers who often included copies of their most recent papers. He kept many of these works, which, along with his annotations, can be found throughout the collection. It appears he used these papers in a variety of ways including as resources for his classes or as reference materials. Arensberg's own work is reflected in his writings and research files. Arensberg's Ireland research, despite its importance to his career and to anthropology as a whole, has a minimal presence in the collection. Located in Series 3. Research Files, the subseries containing Arensberg's Ireland material primarily consists of photocopies of his correspondence, field notes, and diaries during this time. His role as a professor, rather than as a researcher or writer, is the most well-represented in the collection. Arensberg formed lasting relationships with many of his students, as evidenced by his continued correspondence with many of them long after their years at Columbia.

Restrictions on Access

Files containing Arensberg's students' grades have been restricted, as have his students' and colleagues' grant and fellowships applications. For preservation reasons, the computer disk containing digital correspondence files from Joel Halpern is also restricted.

Processing Note

The papers of Conrad M. Arensberg were prepared for deposit at the National Anthropological Archives by Vivian E. Garrison Arensberg. The papers arrived at the archives partially organized, with a general description of the contents written on the record storage boxes. Some of the materials were in labeled folders, but most were not. Original folder titles were retained. Folder titles assigned by the archivist are indicated by square brackets. Files have been rehoused in acid free folders. The archivist kept existing groupings and organized the collection into eight series. While the materials were organized into several natural series—correspondence, teaching materials, Eastern and Central Europe, and industrial relations files, several series—writings, biographical files, professional activities, and research files—were imposed by the archivist with the help of biographical information as well as Arensberg’s curriculum vitae. These materials were scattered throughout the collection and had to be brought back together. Restricted materials were separated and replaced with notes indicating original and new locations.

Series Description and Container List

Series 1. Correspondence. 1933-1994

8.3 linear feet

This series contains most of Arensberg's correspondence. Some correspondence, however, can be found throughout the collection alongside related materials such as his research files. The bulk of his correspondence is professional and documents his exchanges and collaboration with colleagues, many of whom frequently wrote to ask for his opinion regarding their most recent research project or draft for publication. Arensberg's commitment to his students can also be seen in his letters, with many relationships lasting long beyond the students' graduate years.

This work resulted in his doctoral dissertation and the publication of two books and various articles. It influenced anthropologists to study modern industrial societies. The diaries, correspondence, and notes in this subseries are photocopies.

SUBSERIES: INDIA

This subseries documents Arensberg's role as the Principal Investigator for the India Community Studies Project in the 1960s. He spent the year in India during 1964. His NIH grant proposal and final report are included.
