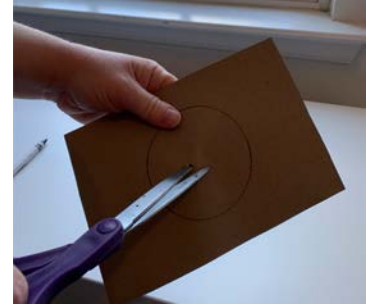


# MAKE YOUR OWN PAPER CAMERA!

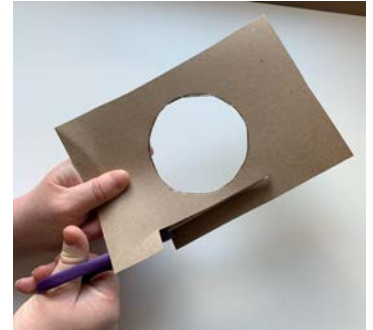
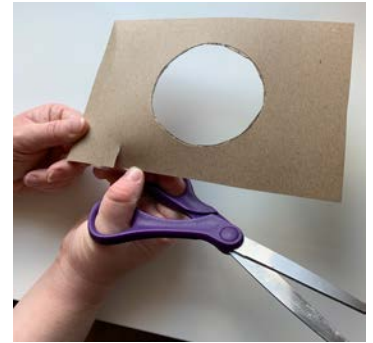

## Materials needed:

- Rectangular piece of sturdy paper or cardboard (8.5" x 5.5")
- Scissors
- Tape
- String, yarn or ribbon (24 - 30 inches long)
- Crayons and markers
- Cup
- Things to decorate your camera (stickers, stamps, etc)

## Instructions:

**Step 1:** Trace a circle in the middle of your paper or cardboard.

**Step 2:** Poke a hole in the middle of your circle, and cut around the circle to make the "lens".

**Step 3:** On the long edge of the rectangle, make a small cut about 1.5 inches away from the corner. Turn your scissors to cut to the other side of the rectangle. This creates your camera button.

**Step 4:** Decorate!

**Step 5:** Attach your string to the back of the camera, using tape or stickers. You can also make two holes with a hole punch or scissors to tie your string to the camera.

**Step 6:** Take your camera with you on your next walk outside or when you look out the window. What observations can you make?
